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This master list is a compilation of all the species records I had in my files from the 1980's, my observations from trips May 26 and September 26, 2000, June 21, July 25, and October 3, 2001 (the latter four trips hosted Jim McCormac of the Ohio Division on Natural Areas and Preserves, and other guests), all species on record from the Division of Natural Areas, timber cruise records, and additional bird observations by Michelle Dunakin of Antwerp, Ohio. The dates in parenthesis below indicate the date of the trip of the past two seasons for which the record was added to the Master List, some of the dates for the birds are from independent trips made by Ms. Dunakin. The inventory was mostly for plants and birds but other species incidentally observed are listed at the end. It does not include the 22 acre north woods (separate list to Mr. Forrest). Scientific nomenclature of plants are after Gleason & Cronquist, 1991. (Additional species not included, especially animals, are listed in *Abbreviated Biological Report* for the replacement of the next bridge upstream for the Paulding County Engineer, June 17, 1985, also by Marshal A. Moser, Jr. Much of that data comes from off the property, though nearby; it has additional likely species for the property, especially fish of the stream.)
